- 3. As Pastor Korey described John 3:16, did it help you understand the purpose of the gift that Jesus came to be for the world? If so, how?
- 4. As you understand the different meanings behind the gifts brought by the wise men, can you relate to the story of the birth of Jesus differently?
- 5. Look at the lyrics of the song, "We Three Kings of Orient Are." Describe if anything new captures your attention about the actions of the Kings or the gifts that were brought.
