- 4. Explain what you heard when PK said, "What you see in others is just a reflection of what you see in you."

Read Matthew 7:5-6, 1st Corinthians 2:15, John 7:24

5. How do we hold the tension as someone who judges correctly, while the world only hears a judgmental person?

Application:

- If you shouldn't judge a tree by its leaves, then should you judge it by its fruits?
- How do we fight against a judgmental spirit within ourselves? What are some little steps we can take to overcome that spirit?
