# **Discussion:**

- 1. Read Genesis 12:1–3. In what ways does God's promise to Abraham change our view of the Christmas story?
- 2. Do you find it difficult to believe the prophecies of Jesus birth, life, and resurrection? Why or why not?

#### Read Isaiah 9:1-7

- 3. What does each title "Wonderful Counselor," "Mighty God," "Everlasting Father," and "Prince of Peace" tell us about the nature of the child?
- 4. How do these titles point to Jesus Christ as the fulfillment of this prophecy?

### Read Isaiah 53.

- 5. When celebrating the birth of Jesus do you think about his life and death as well?
- 6. Verse 6. Do you see yourself included in the phrase... "All of us like sheep have gone astray?" Explain.
- 7. Review God's mercy and grace shown throughout this passage. What should be our response? Pick out at least one circumstance where you want more of God's grace in you.

# Read John 8:31-36, Matthew 6:25-33, John 10:10

- 8. God's gift of Jesus encompasses more than just salvation. What do you need more of in your life that God is offering through a relationship with Him? (examples given in the sermon... Freedom, freedom from worry, burden-free living, freedom from addictions, abundant life)
- 9. What other gifts has God given you through your relationship with him?
