- 2. What does their use of "Hosanna" and the palm branches say about their expectations of a king?
- 3. In what ways do we sometimes treat Jesus as a king who serves our plans rather than one we follow?

#### **Read 1 Samuel 8:5-18**

- 4. What did Israel want when they asked for a king?
- 5. How does God respond to their request, and what does this reveal about the human heart?
- 6. What parallels do you see between Israel's desire for a king and the things we sometimes place above God in our lives?

- 7. Which of these "false kings" do you find yourself most tempted to follow—and/or is there another one not listed here that competes for your heart?
